REASON THE BEAGLE WAS PLACED FOR REHOMING

Owner was diagnosed with personal health issues which means she needs to move back to Scotland to seek the support of family.

All Beagles placed for adoption through the Beagle Club of Queensland Inc. rehoming service are desexed, vaccinated, wormed and microchipped, as well as having had a recent veterinary inspection. They have also had a behaviour assessment with an approved canine behaviour trainer.

The following information relates to the medical condition and requirements, and the outcomes of the behaviour assessment undertaken on the Beagle.

CURRENT KNOWN MEDICAL CONDITION

Mild IBS which is well under control with feeding a grainfree diet.

SUMMARY OF BEHAVIOUR ASSESSMENT FROM BEHAVIOUR REPORT

Buddy bonds well to humans and other dogs, and enjoys his walks and plays with other dogs of all breeds on his daily trips to the park. He can bark excitably when hungry but he also responds well to commands and ceases upon instruction.
